# TURN DEBT INTO HOPE CAMPAIGN - New!

This year's Fall Action is a continuation of the **Turn Debt into Hope Campaign** which was launched during Lent of this year. The focus will be on developing further awareness of the effect of unjust debt on countries in the Global South, participating in a Solidarity Walk and encouraging members of our communities (parishes and beyond) to sign the petition.

At the beginning of this Jubilee Year of 2025, Development and Peace – *Caritas* Canada (DPCC) suggested that the CCCB consider publishing a Pastoral Letter on debt forgiveness, similar to the initiative sponsored by the Conference in 2000. The CCCB President invited DPCC to submit a proposal for consideration by the Permanent Council.

At its March 2025 meeting, the Permanent Council received a draft text and asked that it be revised by the Episcopal Commission for Justice and Peace.

Having been revised by the Commission, and then approved by the Permanent Council at its meeting of June 2025, the document entitled *Forgive us our Debts: Pastoral Letter on Debt Forgiveness in the Jubilee Year 2025* will be published in the Commission's name on Monday, 28 July 2025.

The letter outlines the current debt crisis impacting many developing countries and calls on "our own government and private creditors in Canada to work with debtor nations to develop – and implement – effective frameworks for debt forgiveness in the spirit of the Jubilee Year."
